#### **APPLICATION**

**STEP 1 - RESUME**: Provide your resume, listing:

- education with current cumulative GPA (Grade Point Average)
- extracurricular activities (such as clubs, athletics, work experience), if any
- awards, honors, and certifications (academic or non-academic), if any
- volunteering or community service, if any

**STEP 2 - ESSAY:** Write an essay with minimum 500 words (and correct grammar, spelling, and flow) that covers at least two (2) of the following questions: (Note: submissions with plagiarism; Al is discouraged)

- What are your career goals (short-term or long-term), related to transportation?
- Why did you choose your planned field of study?
- How has transportation impacted your life?
- Why is the transportation industry important to your community?
- How would this financial resource enhance your success toward the transportation industry?
- How do you think your coursework and/or life experiences have helped you prepare for your college studies and the future?

**STEP 3 - LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION**: Provide two letters of recommendation. Letters can be written by teachers, school staff, counselors, employers, coaches, etc. Letters from family members are not allowed. The person submitting the letter should state how they know you and your ability to benefit from the scholarship. Letters must be included with your complete application packet.

**STEP 4 - ACCEPTANCE LETTER/PROOF OF ENROLLMENT**: Provide your proof of acceptance or enrollment to a college, university, or vocational/trade school for classes in the Fall 2025 semester.

**OPTIONAL**: Additional documents can be included with the application that may be pertinent to the evaluation of the applicant as a potential COMTO scholarship recipient, such as portfolio.
